Dear Eustis-Farnam Parents, Students, Patrons, and Staff:

Monday, November 16, 2020, Southwest Nebraska Public Health Department moved the COVID-19 Risk Dial to the “red” category. As you know, Eustis-Farnam is now requiring masks for all school personnel, students and visitors. Eustis-Farnam Schools will remain a “required mask” area until further notice.

During this continued pandemic, Eustis-Farnam Schools are confident the District can remain open if we can adequately staff our facilities and provide a productive learning environment for students. That said, we can’t predict the future. In an effort to better prepare for what could be required for students and staff, EF will be practicing online/remote learning on Monday, November 23, and Tuesday, November 24. K-12 teachers will be teaching remotely from school to students who will be home. This should give students and parents an idea of how remote learning will work. It should also give the District an idea if adjustments need to be made to presentation methods. There will not be school on Wednesday, November 25, and EF will return to “normal” school on Monday, November 30, provided the buildings can be adequately staffed with appropriate personnel.

During these remote learning practice days for students and staff, no meals will be served by the school.

The teachers will be helping your children prepare for next week but if you have specific questions, I would encourage you to contact the teacher.

In addition to required masks, EF is still encouraging physical distancing where possible, frequent hand washing, illness monitoring and urging students to stay home if not feeling well.

The District hopes to not have to use remote learning. However, in the event we do, we should be better prepared. Eustis-Farnam appreciates your continued support and cooperation during this difficult time and pray you stay healthy and safe and have a Happy Thanksgiving with your families.
