Kindergarten- Mrs.Schmidt: Backpack, 2 Boxes of markers with black and brown,
2 Boxes (24 per box) of Crayons, **PE Shoes, #2 Pencils (they sharpen the best),
2 Bottles of Elmers SchoolGlue (no glitter/gel), 4 Glue Sticks, Pencil Box to hold supplies, Beach Towel for rest time (no mats please), Paint Shirt (Parent's old t-shirt), Scissors, 2 boxes of fine tipped dry erase markers

First Grade – Mrs. Wetovick: Several #2 Pencils, Eraser, Glue Sticks, Crayons, Family size box of Tissues, Scissors, ** PE Shoes, Paint Shirt, Colored Pencils, Markers, Small Pencil Box, and a Notebook

Second Grade – Mrs. Loshonkohl: Markers, Crayons, Several # 2 Pencils, Scissors, Paint Shirt (label with name), Colored Pencils, Backpack, Glue Sticks, Pencil box to hold supplies, Eraser
